## The *New Letters* Writing Conference

for Three college credits:  
English 438, section 0002

To enroll in this conference for three credits (English 438, section 0002), you must have taken at least a beginning college course devoted exclusively to the type of creative writing you choose as your focus at the conference: e.g., the writing of poetry, fiction, creative nonfiction, playwriting, or screenwriting (choose one).\*

Examples:

\*Beginning courses at UMKC that would satisfy this requirement include English 312 (fiction writing), 315 (poetry writing), 316 (nonfiction). Such courses need not have been taken at UMKC but should be equivalent, college-level, creative-writing courses, exclusive to one genre. A fiction-writing course, such as English 312, could serve as preparation for both fiction and nonfiction students.

\*Rhetoric and composition are basic to all students and will not serve as a prerequisite for three credits of English 438, even if they included some creative writing.
